The attached is General Electric Company's original NRC License application for 7,000 Kgs U-235 contained in 170,000 Kgs Uranium and 190,400 Kgs Uranium Dioxide Powder (UO₂) ranging from natural up to a maximum of 5.0% enrichment to be exported to Nuclenor S.A. for Garona Reactor in Burgos, Spain (Reload No. 20 thru 27). We currently hold NRC XSNM01645, Amendment No. 04 to cover shipments. However, this license expires 31 December 1996. Instead of amending this license to extend the expiration date, you recommended that we apply for a new license. As we now hold a long term contract with Nuclenor S.A., we are requesting an expiration date of 31 December 2014.

Enclosed also is General Electric Company's check # 0011511188 in the amount of \$3,000.00 payable to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the processing and issuance of this export license as required by law. This export license is required as soon as possible.
