Transmitted herewith is a report of an initial inspection of the subject licensee's uranium ore processing mill.

The items listed in paragraph six of the enclosed report were discussed with Norman A. Grant, Project Manager; G. K. Coates, Mill Superintendent; and, Burt Moulden, Employee Relations and Radiology, at the termination of the inspection. Mr. Grant's proposals for correcting the items appear where applicable in the body of the report.

It should be noted that the employee exposures to concentrations of airborne natural uranium in excess of AEC standards were reported to AEC in a letter dated October 31, 1962. In a letter dated November 2, 1962, the licensee requested that they be exempted from the requirements of Section 20.103(b) in that, they be allowed to adjust exposure to correspond to 40 hours occupancy in a calendar week or to 480 hours occupancy in 84 consecutive days. It is our opinion that the granting of the aforementioned exemption would preclude the possibility of future overexposures.

This report is forwarded to you for appropriate enforcement action. We do not plan to conduct a follow-up inspection.
