Dear Mr. McDonough:

This refers to your export license application dated May 15, 1990, our number XCOM1041, which requested a license to export mechanical plugs to Westinghouse European Service Center, in Belgium, for installation in nuclear power reactors located in Czech Republic, Finland, Hungary, Poland, Slovak Republic and the U.S.S.R. (later amended to Russia).

After receipt of favorable Executive Branch views, the NRC issued Export license XCOM1041 on August 7, 1991 authorizing exports to Czech and Slovak Republics.

We are returning without action your request to export to Finland, Hungary, Poland and Russia. The Executive Branch has concluded that the necessary determinations for a recommendation of approval under the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, cannot be made at this time with respect to Poland and Russia; Hungary will not provide the required assurances without a specific order from their industry; and, exports to Finland may now be made under NRC's general license authority in 10 CFR §110.26.

In a recent amendment to our export and import regulations in 10 CFR 110, NRC added Finland as a country to which any person or company may export nuclear reactor components under general license authority. A copy of the July 8, 1996 Federal Register notice which announced the most recent changes to our export regulations, including revision of §110.26. I have also enclosed an updated copy of 10 CFR 110 for your use.

This refers to your export license application dated May 15, 1990, our number XCOM1041, which requested a license to export mechanical plugs to Westinghouse European Service Center, in Belgium, for installation in nuclear power reactors located in Czech Republic, Finland, Hungary, Poland, Slovak Republic and the U.S.S.R. We are returning without action your request to export to Finland, Hungary, Poland and Russia. The Executive Branch has concluded that the necessary determinations for a recommendation of approval under the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, cannot be made at this time with respect to Poland and Russia; Hungary will not provide the required assurances without a specific order from their industry; and, exports to Finland may now be made under NRC's general license authority in 10 CFR §110.26.
