REPLY TO FORM AEC-592

A phone call to Mr. G. K. Coates was made on September 11, 1964, regarding the adequacy of the response to Item 5.a., of the Form AEC-592 transmitted to the licensee on August 28, 1964. Mr. Coates stated that, in addition to the indicated action, he was planning to request a license amendment that would authorize release of the liquid effluent to the unrestricted area with concentrations of thorium-230 in excess of the specified limit. However, he had not asked Mr. Crozier to use this intended action as the reply to the Form AEC-592 because he felt that such an answer would have been considered inadequate. He again mentioned that he had tried to acquire additional land to build and enclose a retention system for the seepage, but had been refused by the Bureau of Land Management.

Mr. Coates also reported that environmental air samples had been obtained at the perimeter of the mill on September 10, 1964.

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
