On behalf of Jno. McCall Coal Company, Inc. and its subsidiaries, it is respectfully requested that the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research meet with representatives of the coal exploration business in order to draft mineral logging rules which are separate from the oil and gas rules and would reflect on coal exploration techniques.

The inability to accurately log coal seam thicknesses would dramatically increase our exploration costs without providing the accuracy required for proper reserve evaluation.
