Mr. Thompson,

I am writing this to answer the demand for information.

First let me state that I have met the order of suspension and have:

① I have no NAC-licensed material in my possession.

② I have suspended all activities under my license

(ie) I have not received, used or transferred any licensed material since my license was suspended.

③ I have and will maintain all my records.

To answer the demand for information:

④ I can not offer any adequate response why my license should not be revoked, in fact I have submitted a letter requesting that my license be terminated. I feel that if the NAC thinks that

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my procedures may in any way risk injury to anyone or in any way adversely effect the health of anyone than I no longer wish to continue the procedure.

However I would like to state that I did not willfully use this material at a location not authorized by my licence. I am honest I believed my licence had been amended to include White Birch Farm. After the 1991 inspection at which time I was cited for doing one procedure at White Birch Farm I requested that my licence be amended to use at various farms in central N.J.

If there was any attempt to willfully use the material at a location not on my licence I would not have kept such accurate records. I know I signed a letter in 1992 but I believed my licence was amended after this time.

As you can see from my records I did not do any procedures at White Birch until 10/19/94 and I believed my licence had been amended.



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To answer your final question of an estimate of exposure I can only state that to the best of my knowledge the time any individual caring for the treated horses was restricted to a minimum for the first 30 days and that any person would spend no more than 5 minutes a day within 30 centimeters of the treated area.

I would also like to state that in approximately 26 years of using radioactive implants I have never had a complaint from a client and I know I have helped many horses to relieve their pain and help cure many ailments which in no other way could have been cured.
