SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY

As a followup to the meeting conducted at the Region II offices on April 23, 1985, this letter transmits the Meeting Summary as recorded by our personnel. The agenda items of this meeting addressed: (1) Georgia Power's quantitative and qualitative evaluation of selected March 1985 requalification examination items; (2) Identified training program deficiencies from this evaluation; (3) Professional concerns with these examination items; and (4) Recommendations for resolution of these concerns.
