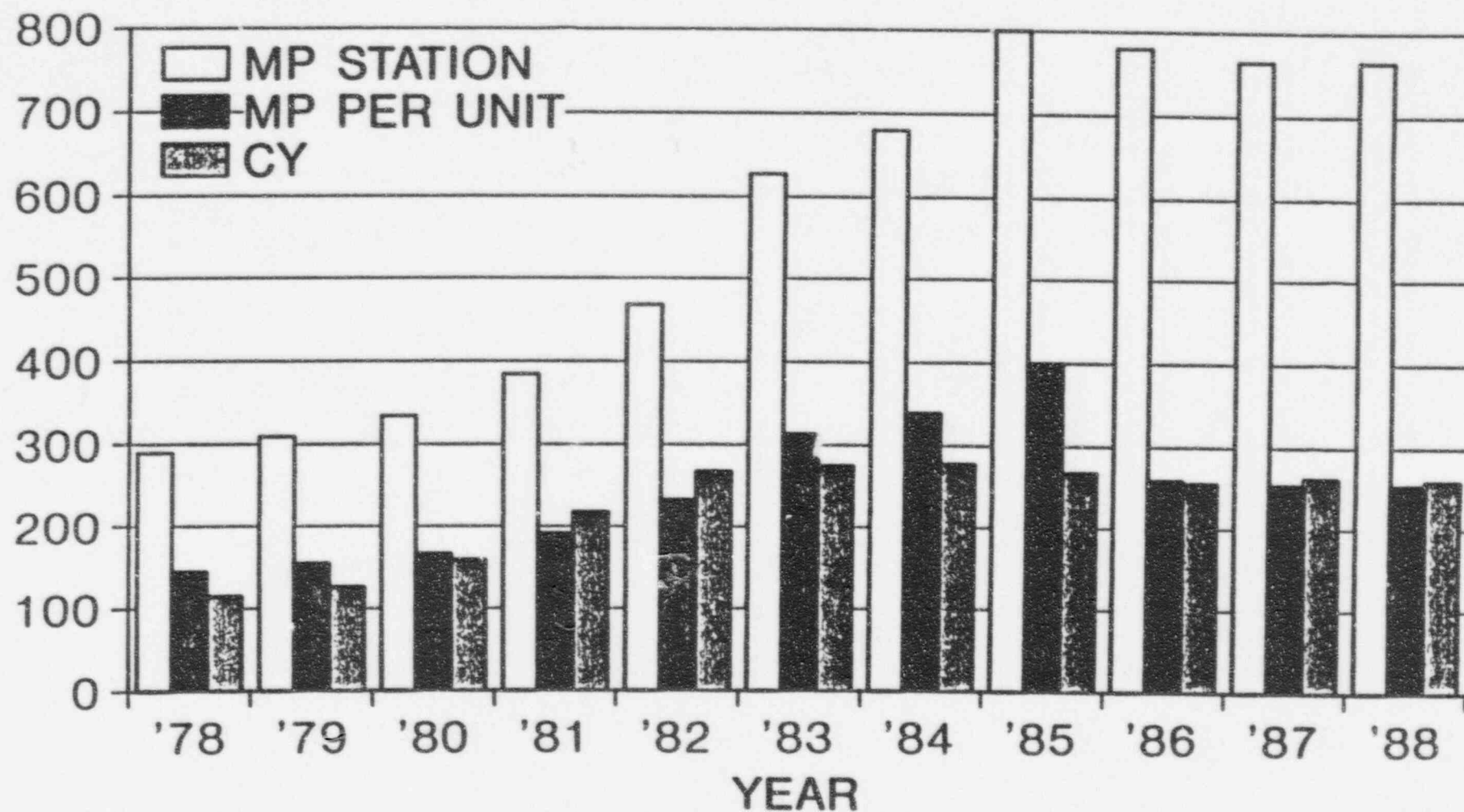

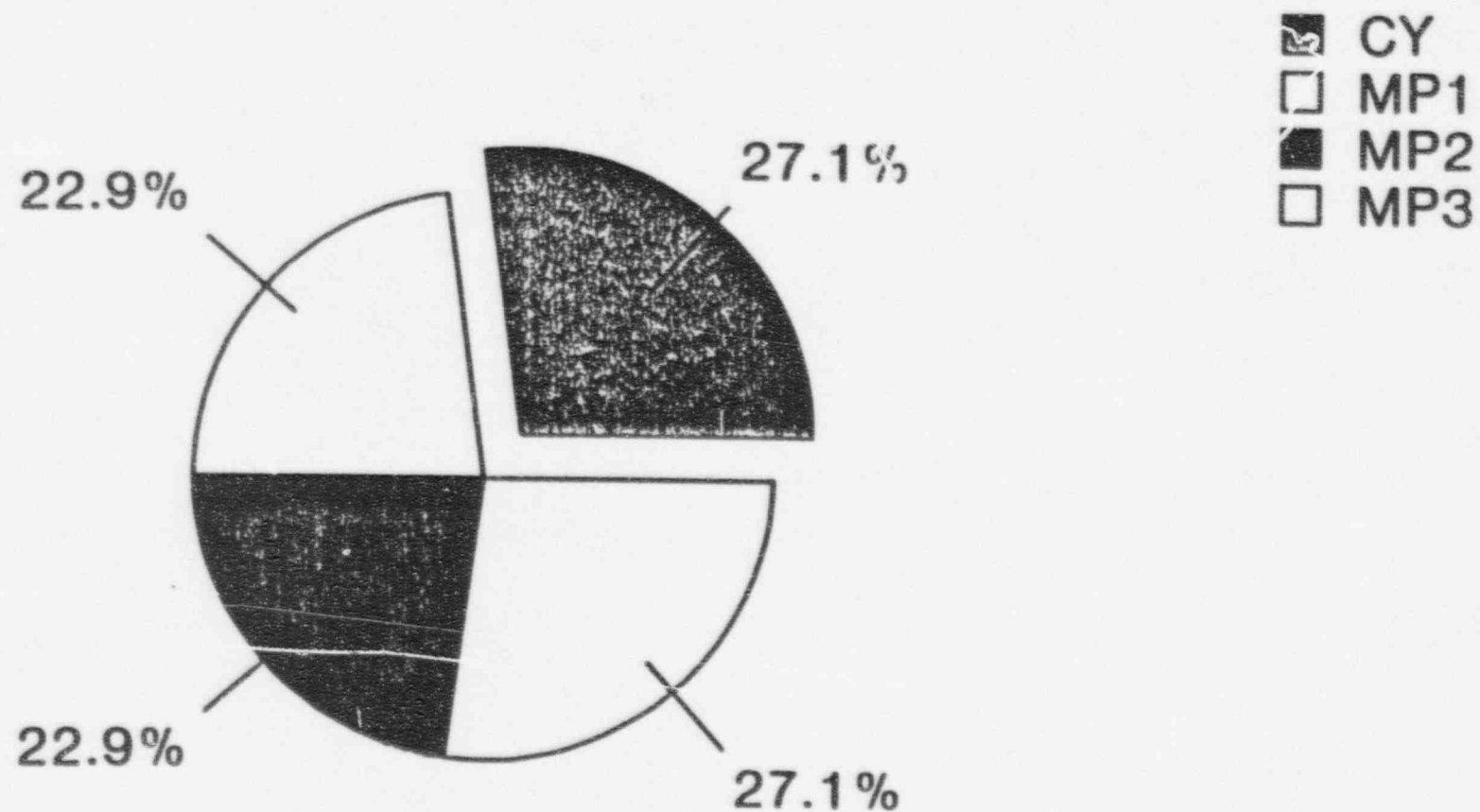

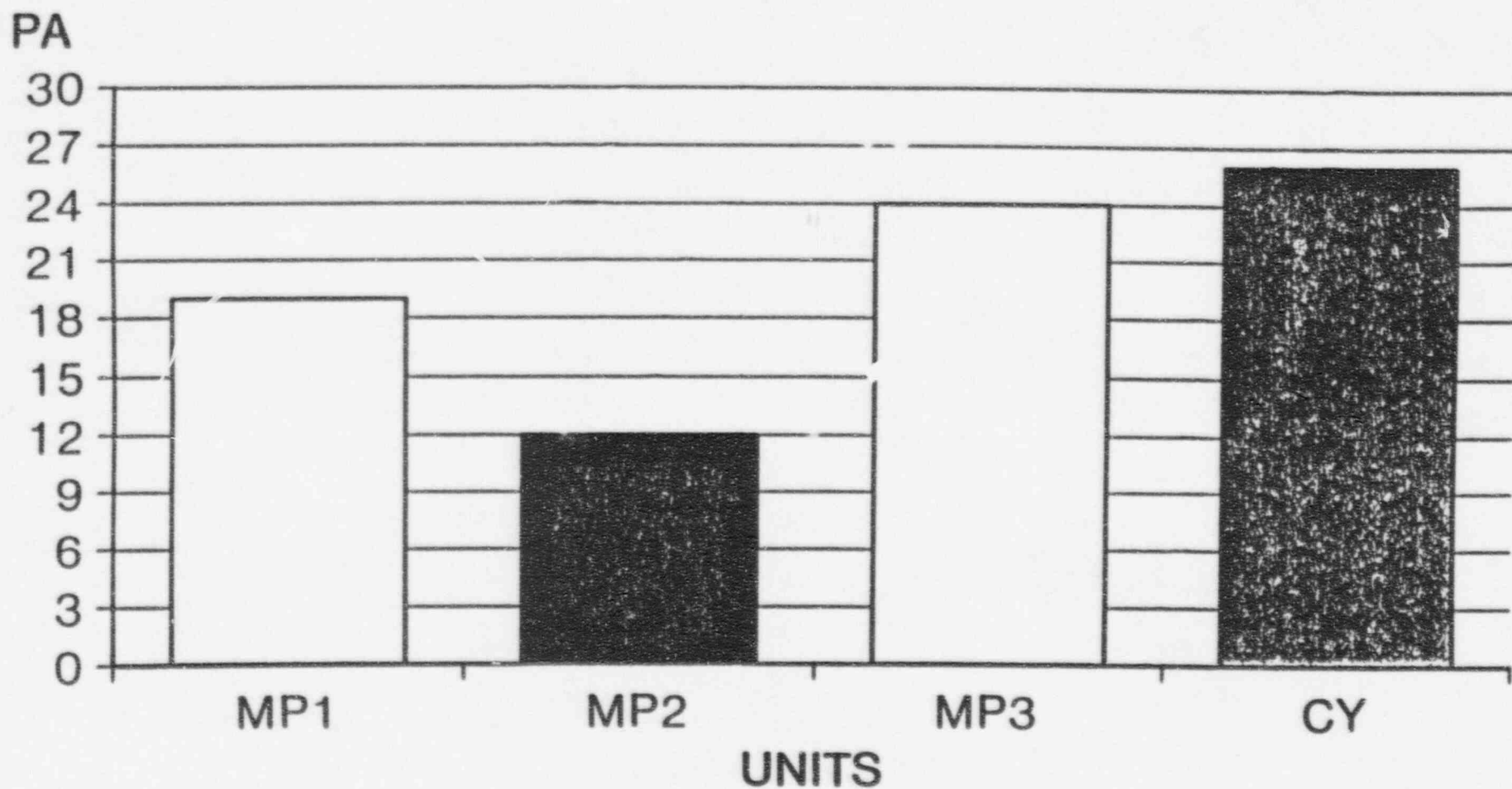
TOTAL STATION STAFF ACTUAL LEVEL



1987 CORPORATE OFFICE SUPPORT OF NU NUCLEAR UNITS BY DEPARTMENTS



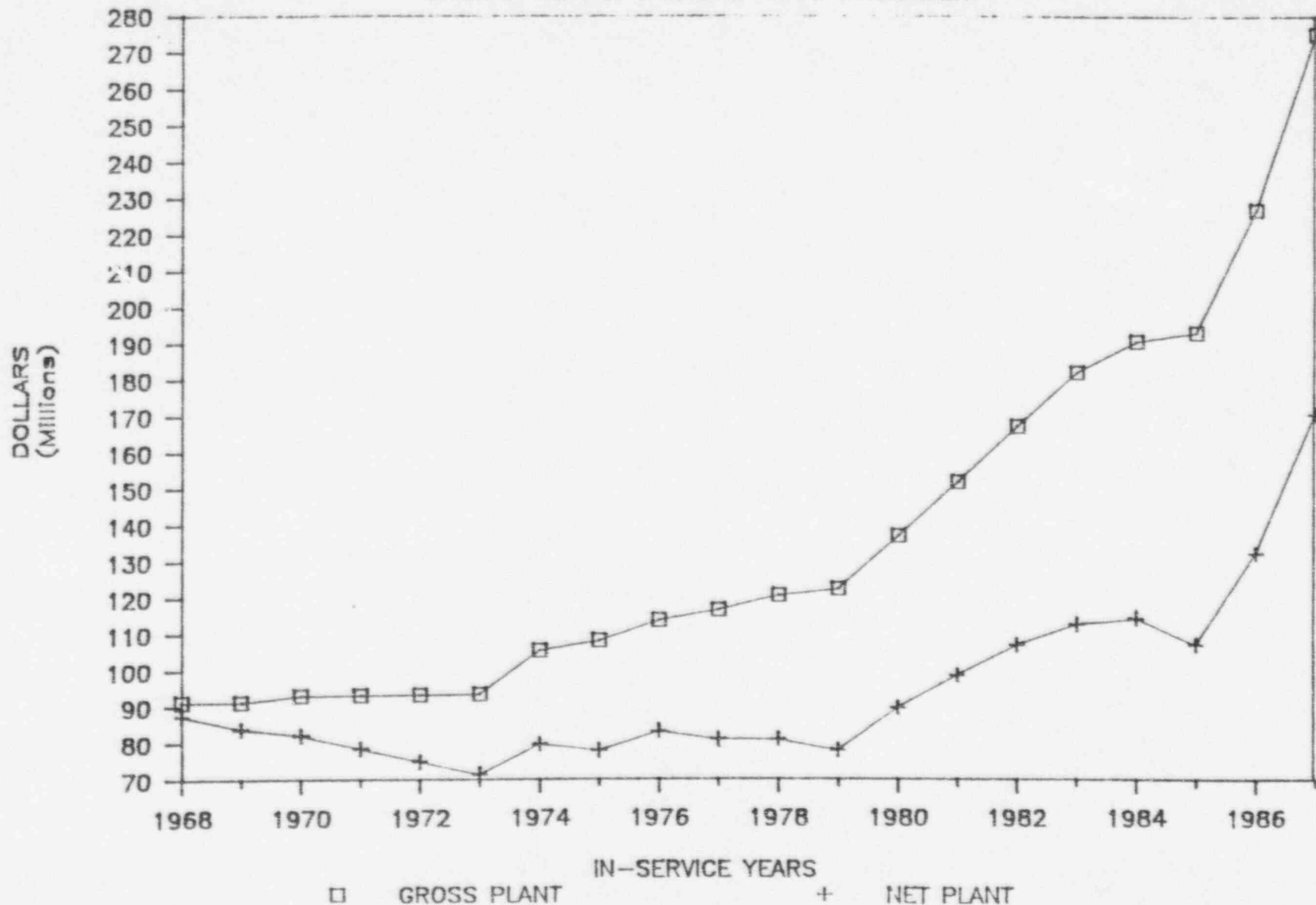
ACTIVE PA COMPARISON
