### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 522, as amended, and 10 CFR 9.8 of the Commission's regulations, the Nuclear Information and Resource Service, on behalf of the Committee to Bridge the Gap, requests all draft versions of NUREG-0956, including but not limited to those titled "Radionuclide Release Under LWR Specific Accident Conditions."

In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive search charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public." The Nuclear Information and Resource Service is a non-profit organization serving local organizations concerned about nuclear power and providing information to the general public. Information required by 10 CFR 9.14a was provided by letter dated August 3, 1984. This FOIA request is submitted on behalf of the Committee to Bridge the Gap, a non-profit organization involved in reviewing the current developments in the "Source Term" controversy. If you should desire to contest the matter of the fee waiver, I request that you give me immediate notification.

I expect a response within the ten working days allowed by law. If you do not intend to make this deadline, I request that a written statement to that effect be provided by you no later than that same date, including a realistic expectation of when the documents will be made available.
