In accordance with letters dated March 19, 1985 and April 8, 1985, License No. 50-23204-01 is amended to read as follows:

License Conditions 10., 12., and 17. are amended to read:

10. Licensed material may be used at 2055 Hill Road; Fairbanks, Alaska; 5621 Arctic Boulevard; Anchorage, Alaska; and at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.
12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, Randall Fletcher; Stephen Adamczak, Jr.; Dean Baldassari; Kenneth J. Depue; Christopher Conder; Scott Wenger; William Burgess; Fred Brown; Tim Terry or any other individuals who have completed the manufacturer's training course, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities course, or the licensee's training course as described in the letter dated March 19, 1985, and have been designated by Randall Fletcher, Radiation Protection Officer.
17. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated July 14, 1983, letters dated August 3, 1983, July 18, 1984, October 4, 1984, November 5, 1984, March 19, 1985 and April 8, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
