response from the Commission concerning these provisions.

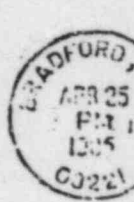
The Commission has made no response to my March 11th letter.

June 21, 1984 and January 15, 1985 concerning health effects in the TMI  
area. We are deeply troubled by what appears to be a withholding of  
information. We request that you inform Mr. Shulte that NRC has these  
motions and what procedures he must follow to obtain them. Kindly send  
us all communications including those between Messrs. Shulte and  
Ingram. We would note that this is not the first time that we have been  
notified that NRC has denied knowledge of our motions.
