
IN RESPONSE REFER

To the Director of Office of Administration:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act as amended
(Title 5, U.S. Code, Section 552).

I wish to obtain copies of all documents in your files pertaining to licensing, inspection and investigation of Mid-States Logging and Perforating Co. and United Wire Line Co., both of which are located in Fairfield, Ill. Mid-States license number is 12-199-8501 and United Wire Line is 12-423-2001. I am particularly interested in an affidavit written by Don Gherardini, manager of Mid-States on May 18 regarding a missing radioactive source. I am also interested in files regarding licensing and inspection processes. I am also interested in records regarding Carl Hubbard, manager of United Wire Line and Don Gherardini, manager of Mid-States, and their histories prior to their employment with their current companies. I am most interested in records dated January 1984 and later.

If all or any part of my request is denied, please list the specific exemption on which you are relying to withhold the information. For any "classified" material withheld, please include the classification, identity of the classifier, date or event for automatic declassification, classification review, or downgrading and, if applicable, the identity of the official authorizing extension of automatic declassification or review past six years and the reasons for extended classification.

If you determine that portions of the requested material are exempt from release, I will expect, as the FOIA requires, that you provide me with the remaining, non-exempt portions.

I am prepared to pay search fees and copying costs up to \$10 for locating and reproducing the requested material, but request that you waive any such fees under the provision of the FOIA that permits you to waive or reduce copying and search fees when release of the requested information would be "in the public interest." If you determine otherwise, please notify me of the costs before filling my request.

As provided by the amended FOIA, I will expect a reply within ten working days. If you have any question concerning this request, please call me at 312-338-0212.
