Please find with this cover letter our completed NRC Form 7 application for export of nuclear material and equipment. This application is in support of our current quotation for the supply of BWR Zircaloy-4 fuel channels for the General Electric-built Laguna Verde Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, near Vera Cruz, Mexico.

I have been in contact with Robin DeLaBarre from the State Department, and he has supplied me with a sample of the language required for recipient government assurances for U.S. exports of nuclear components. We have included a statement in our proposal that this language must be agreed to and signed by a duly authorized official on behalf of the Country of Mexico and forwarded to our State Department and the Mexican Ministry. We are hopeful that this request may help expedite the assurances required since CFE is a government entity.

Please let me know if there is any additional information I may supply with our application.
