The Atlanta Field Office of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Office of Investigations, is currently conducting a high priority investigation of alleged false statements regarding the operability of diesel generators by senior management personnel at the Vogtle Electric Generating Station (OI Case No. 2-90-020). The Field Office Director in Atlanta is Mr. James Vorse and the case agents are Mr. Larry Robinson and Mr. Craig Tate (FTS 841-6502).

In the course of this investigation, a confidential informant provided a number of poor quality micro-mini cassette tapes recorded independently by the informant. Our interview strategy is to confront the senior executives with these tape recordings to elicit their response. There are 17 pertinent cassettes, 4 of which are needed to accomplish interviews within the next few weeks.

I am requesting your assistance to enhance the 17 cassettes and determine if they have been altered or tampered with in any way. I realize that the urgency involved may be somewhat of a problem considering your own busy schedule. However, I would appreciate anything you can do to support our efforts.
