Reply to a Notice of Violation

The following is our response to the notice of violation documented as a result of **Routine Inspection No. 030-03754/96-001** conducted by Region I personnel from May 7 through 9, 1996.

- A. "Condition No. 11.A of License No. 06-00217-06 requires that licensed material be used by or under the supervision of individuals designated in writing by the Radiation Safety Committee.

Contrary to the above, as of May 9, 1996, licensed material was used by or under the supervision of individuals who had not been designated in writing by the Radiation Safety Committee. Specifically, at a September 30, 1994 meeting of the Radiation Safety Committee, the Committee delegated authority for designating certain radioactive materials users to the Radiation Safety Officer and/or his designees.

- (1) The reasons for the Violation were: a mistaken interpretation of the Radiation Safety Committee's authority to delegate the above mentioned authority to the Radiation Safety Officer and/ or his designees and ambiguities in the minutes of the September 30, 1994 meeting. The violation is accepted.
- (2) The corrective action has been taken. Specifically, at the June 20, 1996 meeting, The Committee reviewed the record to assure that no untrained or unqualified individual (in accordance with Radiological Protection Instructions and Radiation Work Permits) had used licensed material (**NONE WERE FOUND**). Further, the delegation of authority for designation of certain radioactive materials users to the Radiation Safety Officer was formally rescinded and written designation was issued. 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
