I Lorraine Creek swear that the following information is true to the best of my knowledge.


I am Secretary of Bob Neiner Farms, Inc. I have been actively involved in the negotiations with Commonwealth Edison for an easement across the property owned by Bob Neiner Farms, Inc. since the middle 1970's.

In 1978 there was a meeting held at the home of Bob Neiner which was attended by Mr. Bob Kinney of Commonwealth Edison, Bruce Larson of the Illinois Commerce Commission, Bob, Eleanor, and Pat Neiner and several other property owners that were actively involved with Commonwealth Edison in negotiations for an easement for a 345kv transmission line and a 765kv transmission line. At that meeting it was stated by Mr. Kinney that the 765 line would be built starting within five years.


Commonwealth Edison through their agents who have changed several times since the middle 70's have always tried to obtain easement rights for both of the lines at the same time. There was never any mention that the 765kv line was not going to be built until the Braidwood facility had four nuclear units or that it would be 25 years or more until they constructed the 765kv line. It was always their representation that the line was to be constructed in relation to the existing first two units at Braidwood.

In my view the Board has the obligation and the right to question the hazards associated with 765kv lines that will carry the power from any station that produces energy that enters the power grid. In the case of Commonwealth Edison the power grid is fed from several points and there is no way of defining what power comes from where or

where it is fed over what lines after it enters the grid. It is entirely possible that the power produced at Braidwood could at some time for any reason be fed into the grid that feeds a 765kv line. Therefore, it is within the duty and the scope of the Board to study the effects of 765kv lines with relation to Braidwood station.
