Ohio law requires all physicians to register (renew) licenses by June 30th of every even numbered year. Applications are mailed approximately March 1st of each even numbered year. ALL PHYSICIANS LICENSED PRIOR TO THAT DATE WILL BE REQUIRED TO REGISTER AND PAY THE RENEWAL FEE, however, those physicians licensed after the date of renewal application mailing will not be required to register or pay the renewal fee until the next biennium. Ohio law also requires 100 hours of continuing medical education for renewal. Enclosed is a CME booklet outlining these requirements.

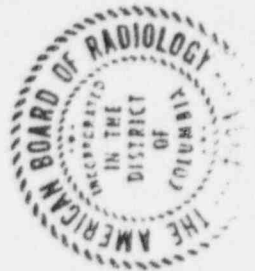

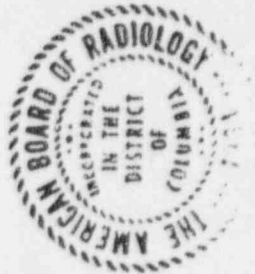
