As a result of a teleconference today between Mr. Virgil Brownlee of your staff and myself, the response to the subject inspection report will be submitted on or before June 7, 1985.

The additional time to respond is needed in order to constructively respond to the violations. The subjects of the violations (use of "N/A" in completing procedures; the use of clearances or temporary procedure changes; definition of system independence; and use of OSIM/AI administrative controls) are complex and will necessitate further discussions within Florida Power Corporation (FPC) and between FPC and the NRC to come to a mutually beneficial understanding.

This is another example where communication between the NRC and FPC will lead to a better regulatory interface.
