Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION/85-01

This refers to the telephone discussion between Miss Judith A. Joustra of this office and yourself on May 7, 1985. From this discussion we learned that you possess a Tracor detector cell which contains radioactive material which requires a specific NRC License. Your possession of this detector cell without a valid, specific license is a violation of Section 30.3 of 10 CFR Part 30. Section 30.3 states:

"Except for persons exempt as provided in this part and Part 150 of this chapter, no person shall manufacture, produce, transfer, receive, acquire, own, possess, or use, byproduct material except as authorized in a specific or general license issued pursuant to the regulations in this chapter."

This Notice of Violation is sent to you under the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office a written statement or explanation in reply including: corrective steps which will be taken to avoid this happening in the future.

Since you plan to continue possessing this detector cell, your corrective steps must include prompt filing of an amendment to include the manufacturer and model number of this detector cell on your NRC License. Accordingly, you must submit the appropriate fee as required by Section 170.31 of 10 CFR Part 170.

You are required to reply to this Notice within 30 days of the date above. Address your reply to Region I, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Attention: John E. Glenn, Ph.D., Chief, Nuclear Materials Section B, 631 Park Avenue, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rule of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.

The response directed by this Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
