Generic Implications of Salem ATWS Events

Reference (1) requested Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) to provide additional information regarding its post-trip review program and procedures for Millstone Unit No. 2 (Item 1.1 of Generic Letter 83-28).

This information was previously provided in Reference (2), which was apparently not reviewed for the Reference (1) Safety Evaluation. However, the procedure included in Reference (2) has since been revised. This revised procedure, SP 2671, Duty Officer Requirements After a Trip or ESF Actuation, and a related procedure, EOP 2525, Standard Post Trip Actions, are attached for your use.
