As a result of recent reorganization changes at our GE Nuclear Energy (NE) facility in Wilmington, N.C., we wish to inform you of how these changes continue to comply with our SNM material license.

Effective 10/11/96, Mr. Tom Hauser was appointed as Acting Manager of Environment, Health and Safety (EHS). Mr. Hauser will also continue in his current position as Manager, NE Quality.

Effective 10/18/96, Mr. Lon Paulson was appointed as the Manager of Nuclear Safety. Mr. Paulson has the criticality safety experience as required by our license. We have also appointed Mr. Allen Mabry as the functional manager for radiation safety, reporting to Mr. Paulson. Mr. Mabry has the radiation safety experience as required by our license.


Section 2.5.3 of our license allows for the functional managerial responsibility of criticality safety and radiation safety to be held by either one or two people. However, each position must hold a BS degree in science or engineering and have five years experience in the nuclear field such as engineering, physics or chemistry. In addition, three years of experience is required for the criticality position and five years experience for the radiation safety position.

Both Mr. Paulson and Mr. Mabry have the required educational and experience background in their respective nuclear field and fully meet all license requirements.
