Subject: 1-95-019, conversation with Doreen BROWNE

On May 18, 1995, I reviewed BARTLIK's and WITTE's NYPA performance files. BROWNE maintains the files for the nuclear department employees, and is William CAHILL's administrative assistant. CAHILL is the NYPA Chief Nuclear Officer.

After reviewing the files, I spoke to BROWNE about a mid cycle performance review that BARTLIK received. BROWNE believed that the original of that document no longer existed, or that it had been given to BARTLIK. BROWNE said that the document never got to her, and that she had not seen it before. BROWNE said that it was never a formal document, or made part of BARTLIK's performance file. BROWNE recalls a concern came up "months ago" about it, and that BARTLIK spoke to CAHILL about the review. CAHILL then "squashed" the mid cycle review. BROWN has had no specific conversation with CAHILL about the review. BROWNE assumes that there was a formal evaluation attached to the narrative section.
