Dear Mr. Schnell:

By letter dated August 19, 1996, as supplemented by letter dated September 13, 1996, Union Electric Company submitted the Second 10-Year Interval Inservice Inspection (ISI) Program Plan Revised Request for Relief ISI-07B. The staff has completed its review of the proposed program revised relief request. The basis for the staff's conclusions are contained in the enclosed safety evaluation.

The staff has determined that for Revised Relief Request ISI-07B, the proposed alternative is unacceptable because the proposed alternative does not provide an acceptable level of quality and safety to ensure that component degradation, as a result of stress corrosion cracking, would be readily identified and corrected. Therefore, Revised Relief Request ISI-07B is denied.
