
This refers to the telephone conversation between yourself and Mr. James M. Allan of this office on May 30, 1985 regarding the training and certification of nuclear moisture density gauge technicians at your Cleveland, Ohio facility.

With regard to this matter, we understand that you will take the following actions:

1. Mr. Carnes of your staff is currently functioning as Radiation Safety Officer for activities involving nuclear moisture density gauges that originate from the Cleveland, Ohio facility.
2. All moisture density gauge technicians currently assigned to your Cleveland, Ohio facility will be retrained and certified by Mr. Carnes before being allowed to use the nuclear moisture density gauges.
3. You will notify this office prior to any change in the individual designated as the Radiation Safety Officer at the Cleveland, Ohio facility.
4. You have suspended all radiographic operations originating from your Cleveland, Ohio facility.

If our understanding of your planned actions, as described above, is not in accordance with the actions being implemented, please contact this office by telephone and in writing within 24 hours of your receipt of this letter.
