A final inspection and survey of vacated facility located one mile south of Healdton, Oklahoma, on Highway 76, was made on October 12, 1981, by our consultant, Keith E. Moon, using a Ludlum Model 14C survey meter. Please reference attached facility drawing on which survey meter readings have been indicated. There were no radiation levels above background found at this facility. No liquid isotope or Iridium baked on sand was ever used at this station; only sealed sources, being AmBe 241 (3 Curies) and Cs-137 (2 Curies). This facility has already been deleted from the Great Guns, Inc. license shown above. (Ref. our letter dated 7/21/81 and amendment dated 8/17/81)

At this time we wish to amend our license to change the Radiation Protection Officer from Wallace L. Pope to S. W. (Bill) Hoffman. As you will note from the attached resume, Mr. Hoffman has a great deal of experience in the oil and gas well logging industry and has a good understanding of the responsibilities and duties of the Radiation Protection Officer. He will work out of our corporate offices in Wichita, Kansas, and will coordinate the radiation safety and health physics program through our station managers.

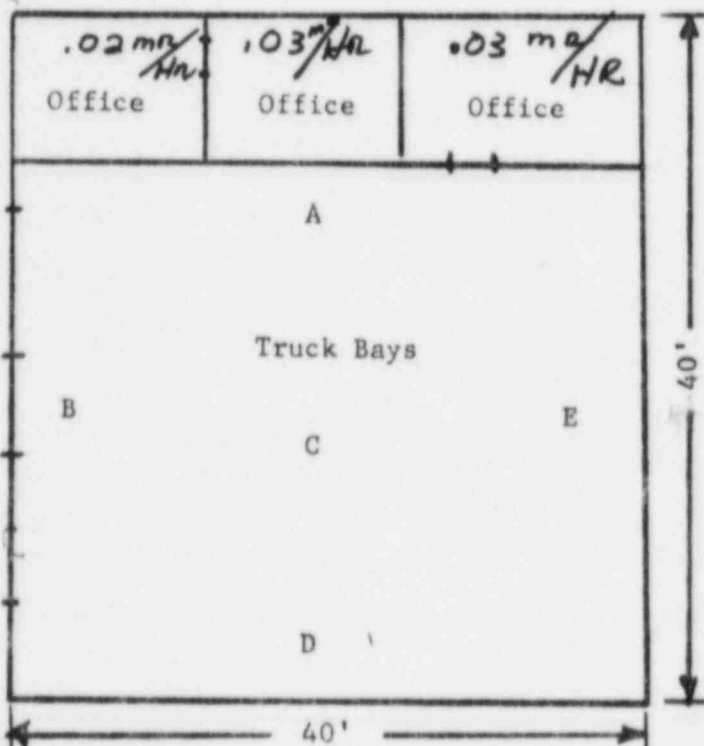
