We have completed review of your letter and past license application requests. Due to number of amendments of your license since the issuance of your last renewal and changes in NRC Regulatory Guidance, it is necessary that you submit a complete application reflecting current facilities and use procedures. We have enclosed NRC Regulatory Guides 10.8, "Guide for the Preparation and Applications For Medical Programs" and 8.23, "Radiation Safety Surveys at Medical Institutions." Your resubmission should incorporate the recommendations outlined in the referenced guides.

Applications for Byproduct Material licenses must be signed by a person authorized to sign on behalf of the institution. This usually will be an executive officer or some other designated official. If it is the hospital's intent to grant Dr. Ervanian authority to make commitments on the behalf of your institution, please so state.
