The Commission met with the NRC staff to provide employees the opportunity to address questions directly to the Commissioners. The audio portion of the meetings was broadcast to NRC Regional Offices, the Technical Training Center, the Walnut Creek Field Office, resident inspector offices, and the Headquarters Public Document Room. Employees at remote sites were able to submit questions by telephone.

The Commission requested the staff to examine whether:

1. reactor site experience has become either an explicit or implicit prerequisite for promotion to supervisory or management positions in either the Regions or headquarters,
2. the potential for promotion opportunities for clerical and administrative staff can be expanded, and
3. funds recovered from the employee recycle program should be used for activities which benefit all NRC employees.
