
Dear Stuart:

Now that all the SSER's, except the Final SSER, have been filed we would like to arrange a meeting with Mr. Noonan and the principle author of each SSER along the lines of the meeting you arranged with the EG&G panel. We would also like to receive all of the documents which were examined by the teams or formed the basis for the SSER's and the TRT findings to the same scope and breadth as what we sought and received for the EG&G data.
