Millstone Nuclear Power Station Unit Nos. 1, 2, and 3
Revised Schedule for the Completion of Corrective Actions

The purpose of this letter is to provide Northeast Nuclear Energy Company's (NNECo) updated plans for the completion of a corrective action developed to address a Notice of Violation (96-05-12) provided in Inspection Report 96-05. In our response to Inspection Report 96-05⁽¹⁾ NNECo committed to complete a root cause analysis to address the missed audit and related deficiencies identified in the audit program by October 31, 1996. The root cause analysis is underway but is not complete at this time. NNECo now intends to complete the root cause analysis by November 27, 1996. This change in schedule was discussed in a telephone conversation between J. P. Durr of the NRC and J. M. Peschel of NNECo on October 31, 1996.


