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SUBJECT: HOSPITALIZATION OF ON-COMING SHIFT SUPERVISOR

The on-coming shift supervisor, assigned to act as refueling supervisor for the day shift, suffered an apparent heart attack or seizure while preparing to go on duty. He was taken by ambulance to the local hospital. The time of event was approximately 7:30 a.m. (CDT), July 18, 1985. This individual's ~~licensee~~ ^{SRO} did have a restriction requiring that a second licensed person be present when he was on duty.

There was no radioactive release or contamination involved.

The licensee does not plan to issue a press release, but will respond to any media inquiries.
