SUBJECT: TELEPHONE CALL TO DR. THOMAS MANCUSO

On February 3, 1978 I spoke to Dr. Thomas Mancuso by telephone. After I identified myself, he said that he was too busy to talk. In response to a question about when it would be convenient to talk with him, he said that he had an office full of photographers and that he would not be able to speak any further. He mentioned that he agreed to meet with NRC representatives in the letter which he had sent to me. This was an accurate account on his part, however, according to the letter, the meeting would be in the context of an adjudicatory hearing on the NRC position to lower the occupational exposure limit. Therefore, I interpret his telephone statement as meaning that he would not meet with us outside of a hearing forum. He also mentioned that he would be attending the Rogers Committee Hearings. In response to remarks on my part about possible support of further analyses of the Hanford mortality experience with his possible role as a consultant he said, "Put it in writing."
