
This is in further response to your letter dated April 22, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 14 categories of records regarding the Three Mile Island nuclear plants and/or General Public Utilities.

By letter dated August 16, 1984, this office noted the fact that the NRC had already made available a voluminous amount of pertinent records, asked for clarification of the scope of your FOIA request, and informed you that your related discovery request of August 3, 1984, would be considered as clarification of the scope of category h of your FOIA request. Subsequently, by letter dated September 11, 1984, this office made certain records related to category h available for your inspection and copying at the NRC's Public Document Room (PDR). Additional records were also provided to you during the hearing and by separate correspondence from the NRC's Office of the Executive Legal Director.

The staff has identified additional records that may be related to category h. These records, which are identified on the enclosed Appendix B, are being placed in PDR folder FOIA-84-311 under your name.

This completes NRC's action on your FOIA request.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 USC §9 (subpart A), Three Mile Island Alert, Inc. hereby requests copies of the following:

Any and all studies, memoranda, reports, letters or other documents, written by, sent to, or routed through any of the following offices and divisions:

- NRC Commissioners and Commissioners staffs
- Office of General Counsel (OGC)
- Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR)
- OR Branch
- AEOD
- EDO
- OPE
- OELD
- Nuclear Regulatory Research
- Office of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E)
- ~~Office of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E)~~
- Office of Investigations (OI)

including but not limited to:

- internal memoranda between NRC staff
- SECY papers
- memoranda or briefing papers for the NRC Commissioners
- draft Congressional testimony
- minutes from meetings

which discuss, evaluate, analyze, or explain the following topics regarding the Three Mile Island Nuclear Plants (TMI) and/or General Public Utilities (GPU) and all of its current and past subsidiaries:

- a). the 1979 material false statement incidents in connections with cheating by Mr. VV, (Unit 2 Supervisor of Operations), including both the August 3, 1979 letter signed by Gary Miller and the November 15, 1979 requalification of Mr. VV.
- b). TMI-1 leak rate falsification.
- c). allegations by TMI-2 clean up workers Richard Parks, Larry King, Ed Gischel, Joyce Wenger, and William Pensyl.

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
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- d). the "Keaton" drafts (i.e., GPUSC's Task Force Investigation into the Unit 2 accident).
- e). GPU/Met Ed's response to the NRC's October, 1979 Notice of Violation in connection with the TMI-2 accident.
- f). possible false statements made by GPU/Met Ed/GPUN employees during the B&W litigation, including discovery.
- g). possible false statements made by either GPU President Dieckamp or GPU Board Chairman Kuhns during GPU's November 28, 1983 presentation to the Commission.
- h). Herman Dieckamp's May 9, 1979 mailgram to the Hon. Morris K. Udall.
- i). the BETA and RHR reports, including whether such reports were improperly withheld from the Commission.
- j). the "Hartman" allegations, (i.e., Unit 2 leak rate falsification).
- k). whether financial considerations have an improper impact on technical decisions.
- l). management changes and/or reorganization of personnel.
- m). the Commission's overall handling to the management "integrity" issues, including directives to OI on how to prioritize and proceed with its investigations.
- n). significant hazard considerations under the "Sholly" amendment regarding the steam generator repairs at TMI-1, including OGC and OELD documents addressing the legal considerations involved.

The requested documents will be used for public education purposes, and will therefore be used in the general public interest. Therefore, we request a complete waiver of all costs you might incur in processing this information or in providing us access to it under provision at 10 CFR \$9, 14a, and the Freedom of Information Act. Nothing in this request should be interpreted as a request for the private records of a specific individual. Hence no provisions of the Privacy Act should be deemed applicable. If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) which you think justifies your refusal to release the information and inform us of the appeal procedures available to us under law.

We will expect to hear from you within ten days.
