Dear Sir:

We are submitting to you, in writing, a notification of the changes which have occurred within our plant since the renewal of our U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License.

Within the past two years, Martin Marietta Corporation has acquired the acquisition of the Company formerly known as Woodville Lime and Chemical. During this period of time, we have been awaiting a decision from the judicial system as to whether we were able to operate the two facilities as one.

These two plant facilities are geologically located beside each other and are joined together with an access road which provides ease of travel from one to the other. Because of the accessibility between plants, the decision has been finalized and we are now one plant.

This brings me to the reason for this notification. We now have two licenses covering our nuclear level sources within our plant and we have also had some changes in our plant personnel.

We wish to inform you that Phil Maupin, the Regulation Safety Officer on license No. 34-13543-01, is no longer employed at Martin Marietta. This leaves only Denny Kelley's name on the license application. We wish to retain his name on the license but we are requesting that you add John Overmyer's name as the new Regulation Safety Officer. John Overmyer has completed the Nuclear Safety Training course provided by Texas Nuclear. We are sending information along with this letter, to confirm this training.

On license No. 34-13692-01, which is the license of the former Woodville Lime and Chemical, there has also been two changes in plant personnel. Mr. Virgil Tadson and Mr. George Judd have left our employment. Mr. Clarence Bloom, the other person named on the license, will soon be retiring.


