In accordance with NUREG 1335, Revision 1, the U.S. Army Area Calibration and Repair Center, Sacramento, California, By-Product Material License Number 04-04279-01, is submitting a Statement of Intent for financial assurance.

In the event that the facility is decommissioned, \$75,000 for sealed sources and \$750,000 for unsealed sources will be requested through channels to the Department of the Army and obtained sufficiently in advance to prevent delays in completing the decommissioning.
