(Corrections to LBP-96-23)

The following corrections are made to LBP-96-23, 44 NRC __ (Oct. 25, 1996):

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4. On page six, in the third line of the text, the word "into" is revised to read "onto".
5. On page six, in the twenty-third line of the text, the phrase "two and" is revised to read "two-and-".
6. On page seven, in the twenty-second line of the text, the word "half" is revised to read "one-half".
7. On page eight, in the second line of footnote six, the word "an" is revised to read "a".
8. On page eight, the fourth line of footnote six is revised to read as follows:
"hearing rights under AEA section 189a, 42 U.S.C. § 2239(a). See Cleveland".
9. On page nine, in the eighteenth line of the text, the phrase "5000 pound" is revised to read "5000-pound".
10. On page nine, in the twenty-second line of the text, the phrase "350 pound" is revised to read "350-pound".
11. On page nine, in the twenty-fifth line of the text, the phrase "2000 gallon" is revised to read "2000-gallon".

13. On page twelve, in the thirteenth line of the text, the word "practicable" is revised to read "practical".

15. On page fourteen, the tenth line of the text is revised to read as follows:

“heavier than a fuel assembly to be carried over spent fuel will violate

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
