Gentlemen:

This refers to your applications dated February 21, 1962, requesting exemption from Section 20.305, 10 CFR 20, to incinerate material containing uranium at your Haven, Rifle, Trace Elements and Globe uranium mills.

In support of your applications we require your procedures to prevent overexposure of personnel to airborne radioactivity during incineration including procedures for airborne radioactivity surveys and procedures for handling the ash.

With regard to the operation of your Trace Elements mill, License No. R-212 is hereby transferred from Trace Elements Corporation to Union Carbide Corporation, 270 Park Avenue, New York 17, New York. All other terms and conditions of the license remain unchanged. Renewal of this license will continue to be considered separately and will not be included in the renewal of License No. R-105.
