Dear Mr. Nussbaumer:

As we discussed by phone Friday, January 11, from time to time we have obsolete, used equipment or salvaged building material which has been used in our uranium ore processing activities and which we wish to dispose of either as scrap or to used equipment dealers.

We are proposing that we be authorized to dispose of this equipment without specific notification on each item providing that it can be decontaminated to meet the specifications specified under Conditions 2, 3 and 4, of your letter of May 10, 1962.

As I suggested, we could furnish you with a report listing material disposed of during a monthly period that would include pertinent survey information obtained prior to its release. Our radiation surveys are made only with qualified personnel using approved methods and equipment. Should you have any questions concerning survey procedures, we should be happy to discuss them further, or if you wish, we would be glad to demonstrate them to one of your field representatives.

We believe that the proposed disposal procedure will be much more workable and convenient than the one we are presently using and at the same time will accomplish the desired control.
