Gentlemen:

Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOG) hereby requests the withdrawal of the application for amendment to Facility Operating License No. NPF-42 for Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) transmitted by the Reference. This license amendment request would have revised Surveillance Requirement 4.1.3.1.3 to allow the control rod drop surveillance test to be performed with T_{avg} below 551°F.

WCNOG has reevaluated the proposed Technical Specification Change and determined that the request should be withdrawn. This proposed change was submitted to the Westinghouse Owners Group (WOG) to be considered for approval as a generic project. However, in their September, 1996, meeting, the WOG General Session deferred action on the request. This amendment request may be resubmitted in the future depending on the results of further WOG action.
