By Federal Register Notice published May 20, 1982 (47 FR 21943), the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) announced the availability of a Draft Environmental Statement (DES) related to the decommissioning of Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation's Rare Earths Facility located in West Chicago, Illinois, with comments on the DES from interested persons due to the Commission by July 6, 1982.

In order to ensure that sufficient time is allowed for public comment, the Commission hereby extends the comment period for the DES an additional 25 days, with comments due for the Commission's consideration by August 1, 1982. Comments should be addressed to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555, Attn: Uranium Fuel Licensing Branch. All comments received by the Commission will be made available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20555, and at the Commission's Local Public Document Room in the West Chicago Public Library, 332 E. Washington Street, West Chicago, Illinois 60185.
