

Enclosed in duplicate is completed NRC Form 313 "Application for Material License", together with supplemental pages and support materials. B & B Perforators is a new company formed to conduct perforating and well logging services for the oil and gas industry around Upton, Wyoming. B & B Perforators is a partnership between myself and my father, Gerald D. Bullard, who is the principal stockholder of Goodwell, Inc. (NRC License #49-12994-01). As you will note in the application, we will use Goodwell's facility and will store radioactive sources at this location.

I will be B & B's only operator at the outset and will serve as the Radiation Protection Officer. As outlined in Page 1 of the Radiation Safety Training Manual (Section 1), we request the condition on our license that will allow me as RPO to designate radiation handlers who have met the criteria stated. Section 2 of the enclosed manual is our Operating & Emergency Procedures. Example forms, facility and bunker sketches, and representative drawings of source assemblies, handling tools, and transport containers are in the rear of the manual.

We have been assisted in the preparation of this submittal by Keith Moon of Support Consultants and Associates, Inc. I have reviewed the enclosed materials and agree with the statements therein. If you have any questions and cannot reach me, you may contact Mr. Moon, as he is authorized to act on our behalf in the acquisition of this license. Our check in the amount of \$700.00 for the license fee is also enclosed.
