9. Authorized use

- A. (1) For receipt, possession, storage, preparation and packaging for shipment, and for distribution to persons authorized to receive the licensed material pursuant to the terms and conditions of specific licenses issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission or Agreement State.
- (2) Demonstration of Series B-100 device/signs at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction.
- B. For receipt, possession, storage, preparation and packaging for shipment, and for distribution to persons authorized to receive the licensed material pursuant to the terms and conditions of specific licenses issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission or Agreement State.

Condition 15. is amended to read:

15. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated May 29, 1984, and letters dated October 9, 1984 and January 8, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
