During the week of August 27-30, 1985, the NRC Pump and Valve Operability Review Team (PVORT) performed an audit at the Clinton Power Station to determine the overall adequacy of the pump and valve operability program.

Due to the number of generic and equipment-specific open items, it was determined that a re-audit would be necessary to assure the adequacy of Illinois Power Company's (IP) program. As discussed with the NRC Clinton Licensing Project Manager, a meeting to present IP's recovery program has been tentatively scheduled for September 26, 1985, in Bethesda, Maryland.

Included in this recovery program presentation will be how this program will resolve the generic open items, and a schedule for resolving the equipment-specific items prior to the re-audit. Also, pending the Staff's concurrence with the recovery program, a date for the PVORT re-audit will be established.
