The attached report by Physicians for Social Responsibility "Eval. of Design Hazards of Airborne Ash and Pyroclastic Flow for the Troyan Power Plant site" was handed to Tom McKenna (NRC) by this group at a recent emergency planning public meeting. On the basis of this report - which is at odds with NRC's evaluation - this group seeks 1) changes in emergency planning and 2) permanent shutdown of Troyan. The group is currently seeking court action (state of Oregon) for a Troyan shutdown. This document has not been submitted to NRC, but it may be - requesting action.
