The hospital is no longer contracting with Health Physics Services, Inc., to manage our radiation protection program. The Radiation Safety Officer, Dr. Russell O. Briere, and the Nuclear Medicine staff will perform most of the functions outlined in the hospital's license application.

Mr. Dean W. Broga is providing radiological health physics consultation to the hospital. Mr. Broga will calibrate our survey meters in accordance with the procedures set forth in NRC license no. 45-00048-17 issued to Virginia Commonwealth University. The hospital requests that its NRC license no. 45-02888-01 be amended to show these changes.

Enclosed please find a copy of the NRC Model ALARA Program which the hospital has adopted. It is requested that this program be incorporated by license condition into the hospital's license.
