Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 05 renewing your NRC License Number 13-03226-03 in accordance with your request.

Please be advised that we have not added Dr. Shannon S. Lamb to your license. In order to add Dr. Lamb as an authorized user you will need to submit the name(s) of the institution(s) as well as the license number(s) (NRC or Agreement State) on which Dr. Lamb is listed as an authorized user for cobalt-60 teletherapy treatments.

Information submitted in response to this letter should state that it is additional information and not a new amendment request.

Please pay particular attention to Conditions 18. and 19. of your license which requires you to perform a radiation survey and submit a survey report:

- a. each time your teletherapy source is replaced.
- b. Whenever you make any changes in the shielding, location or use of your teletherapy installation that could affect radiation levels in surrounding areas.

A report of the results of the required survey should be sent to:

- a. The Material Licensing Branch, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555 and
- b. the Director of the appropriate NRC Regional Office of Inspection and Enforcement (see Appendix D to 10 CFR Part 20.)

These reports should be sent not later than thirty (30) days following the installation of a new source or completion of the changes requiring the survey.

Based on a review of your inspection history, it appears that you replaced the teletherapy source on February 19, 1982; however, you did not submit a survey as required by the above referenced License Condition until Mr. J. Mullauer, an inspector with our office, requested this information and it was submitted in a March 29, 1984 letter.

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Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.
5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170.
6. Submit a complete renewal application with proper fee or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
7. Request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving radioactive material prior to your expiration date.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions and representations in your license application will result in enforcement action against you in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.
