Draft 3 to Revision 0 of the
Millstone Nuclear Power Station Emergency Plan

Enclosure 2 to Reference (1) and Reference (2) contained comments pertaining to the NRC Staff's review of Draft 2 to Revision 0 of the Millstone Nuclear Power Station Emergency Plan (MNPSEP), which was submitted in Reference (3). We responded in Reference (4) to those comments as well as those items identified during the Millstone Unit No. 3 Emergency Preparedness Appraisal that were related to the MNPSEP.

In Reference (4), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) indicated that Revision 0 of the MNPSEP was scheduled to be submitted to the NRC Staff by September 13, 1985 and implemented on October 15, 1985. We hereby submit Draft 3 to Revision 0 of the MNPSEP for review by the NRC Staff. The attached MNPSEP is consistent with our responses contained in Reference (4), and we trust that all NRC Staff concerns related to the MNPSEP are now adequately resolved. A cross-reference between the items in Reference (4) and applicable sections in the MNPSEP is included for the NRC Staff's convenience.

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We wish to emphasize that the attached MNPSEP is a draft plan and that all personnel who are responsible for reviewing and/or approving the MNPSEP have not yet completed their respective reviews. We are providing this draft at this time to allow the NRC Staff and ourselves to simultaneously review the revised MNPSEP.


Our objective is to implement by October 15, 1985 a revised MNPSEP which will fully resolve all NRC Staff concerns. Before we can initiate our final and formal review process to meet this objective, we need to be assured that the revised MNPSEP fully resolves all NRC Staff concerns. We believe the attached MNPSEP accomplishes that. Nonetheless, in order to meet our objective, it is necessary that we receive any remaining NRC Staff comments no later than September 25, 1985. Receipt of comments prior to that time would be greatly appreciated and would expedite our formal review process, the result of which will be the formal submittal to the NRC Staff of the final Revision 0 to the MNPSEP.

We look forward to your prompt review of this submittal.




