The meeting provided Georgia Power Company (GPC) an opportunity to demonstrate the ability of their ultrasonic examination procedure and equipment to detect, locate, and size actual crack flaws propagating from the pipe inside diameter in centrifugally cast stainless steel as discussed in the enclosed report.
