

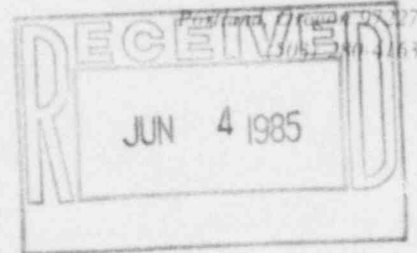


This letter is a follow-up of St. Patrick Hospitals' recent application to amend their license to permit transfer of radioactive materials to Missoula Community Hospital. The letter also addressed the use of the Group VI Cs-137 sources as calibration sources for survey meter calibration.

In regards to the first issue, transfer of radioactive material, you indicated that no amendment was necessary as St. Patrick Hospital does not transport the material. Would you please send a letter to this effect to St. Patrick Hospital, attention Shelda Hames?

Regarding the second issue, use of St. Patrick Hospital Cs-137 sources for other institution calibrations, please withdraw this request. As was discussed over the telephone please consider the possibility of authorizing calibration of the W.M.R.C.C. survey meters through David Rickles, M.D. (the authorized user on the St. Patrick Hospital Group VI license).

I will be out of town until June 3, but I will call upon my return to see if we can resolve this issue.
