RE: Emergency Amendment Application, License 25-16773-02, St. Patrick Hospital, Transfer of Radioisotopes.

Dear Mr. Whitten:

Please amend St. Patrick Hospital's radioactive material license to allow for the transfer of specific radioisotopes (listed below) to Missoula Community Hospital. Procedures relating to this matter are as follows:

1. The transfer of a maximum amount of any one day of:
 - 200 mCi Tc-99m
 - 3 mCi Tl-201
 - 1 mCi I-131 (diagnostic capsules)
 - 20 mCi I-131 (therapeutic, hyperthyroid-infrequent)
2. All transfers are to be logged to specify:
 - A. Lot number
 - B. Isotope
 - C. Quantity (mCi)
 - D. Date
3. Radioisotopes prepared for transfer are enclosed in lead "pigs" to reduce exposure levels to less than 2mR/hr. at container surface. "Radioactive Material" labels are affixed to containers. Missoula Community Hospital supplies the van and transport.
4. Disposal. It is understood that radioactive material transferred to Missoula Community Hospital is left there, stored until decayed.



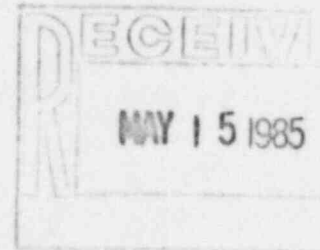

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
