Gentlemen:

This is in regards to your letter dated April 5, 1985, which transmitted revised portions of Section 4.5.3 of your Fundamental Nuclear Material Control (FNMC) Plan.

Our review of the referenced submittal under the provisions of 10 CFR 70.34 has determined that your request is acceptable and will not decrease the effectiveness of your safeguards program and will not adversely affect the common defense and security nor the public health and safety, and is otherwise in the public interest. We are also taking this opportunity to recognize Region II's approval of 10 CFR 70.32(c) submittals dated December 28, 1984, and January 10, 1985. Accordingly, License Condition 2.1 to Amendment MPP-3 to License No. SNM-1097, is hereby revised, effective immediately, to read as follows:

- 2.1 The licensee shall follow the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan dated June 24, 1977; as amended according to the schedule of pages dated January 10, 1985, transmitted by his letter from Charles M. Vaughan to J. P. O'Reilly (Region II) dated January 10, 1985, with the exception of Items 2 through 5 delineated by the letter from J. Phillip Stohr (Region II) to J. A. Long dated August 10, 1984; the letter to W. B. Brown (Fuel Facility Safeguards Licensing Branch) dated December 9, 1983, with the changes noted in the attached Attachment 1; the FNMC Plan pages dated November 3, 1984 (UPMP) and April 5, 1985; and as may be further revised in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c).

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Pages 3-16 through 3-22 and Pages 7-7 through 7-17 marked "demonstration" use typical values for plant inventory and upper action limits for process control. Actual values for inventory, action limits, and custodial assignments will be maintained separately by licensee management on a current basis. Appendix A site description and Appendix D descriptive data for annual inventory are included for clarification and are not part of the FIMC Plan.

We have determined that the attachment to your April 5, 1985, letter contains information of the type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1), such information is deemed to be commercial or financial within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4), and shall be withheld from public disclosure, unless subject to the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.
